Health Guarantee/Contract

The following contract is between 606 Family Farm Co. Goldens and the buyer for the purchase of a puppy from 606 Family Farm Co. Goldens.

Our puppies are vet-checked prior to being sold to assure you, the buyer, of their health. We guarantee each puppy to have immunizations and worming medication as is age appropriate. We will provide a schedule of immunizations completed, and those still to be given in the future. Should the puppy develop any congenital medical disorder during the first 12 months of life or if a puppy dies within the first year, of congenital defects, 606 family farm will replace that puppy with another of equal value when we have a litter available. A veterinarian must determine that the death is a result of congenital defects, and we reserve the right to have our own veterinarian confirm the diagnosis. Should this puppy be determined to be suffering from a fatal defect deemed to be hereditary, 606 family farm goldens will replace the puppy with one of the same value when one is available after notification and written verification has been furnished to the Breeder by TWO independent veterinarians. The breeder will not be responsible for any veterinary costs at any time. We cannot guarantee that your puppy will never develop any health problems, just as a pediatrician cannot guarantee that a child will never develop any health problems in the future. Some things are just not able to be predicted. Our parents are free of diseases, disorders, and health problems; otherwise we would not breed them. That means our puppies are less likely to develop problems. If anything does occur, you are required to inform us so we can evaluate the parents and the other puppies from that litter in an attempt to determine the cause of the ailment and to eliminate the issue from our breeding program. This puppy is in good health at the time of sale. The buyer will have 72hrs in which to have the puppy examined by their own veterinarian. Failing to do so will void the health guarantee. If

the puppy is found to be ill by a licensed veterinarian and is to be returned due to illness, a letter from the veterinarian is required. This includes death or illness from any health condition deemed to be present prior to the leaving the seller's premises (606 family farm). Buyer shall assume any expenses associated with returning the puppy to the seller. The seller will, at the seller's discretion, refund the purchase price, return the dog to the buyer in healthy condition, OR exchange the dog for another dog of equal value. At no time and under no circumstances will the Breeder be responsible for any veterinary expenses incurred by the buyer. 606 Family Farm Co. is not liable for long term medical care or treatment if so chosen by the buyer. Breeder does NOT GUARANTEE against COCCIDIA or GIARDIA (typically dormant single celled parasites common in puppies) or for final adult weight, color, breeding ability, show potential or against overbites, under bites, patella issues, hernias, trachea issues or for undescended testicles and other treatable issues. Seller agrees to notify buyer if they or the vet discover any of the above problems prior to sale. The Buyer Agrees: That this puppy will be given adequate and proper shelter and housed securely indoors. This dog shall not be neglected, allowed to roam free, or be mistreated in any manner. The puppy shall receive proper veterinary care throughout its life, receiving annual inoculations and placed on a heartworm preventative. The puppy shall receive proper nutrition and care shall be taken to maintain its proper weight. Buyer agrees to give the dog proper training and socialization. Buyer agrees to never sell or surrender this dog into a dog fighting institution, testing center or shelter. The Buyer agrees to finish all puppy vaccines before taking their puppy out in public, letting their puppy on

public sidewalks and grasses, or letting their puppy be touched by people outside of the family. This reduces the chance of your puppy picking up a communicable disease such as Parvo. Buyer

DEPOSIT FOR RESERVING A PUPPY:

A \$350 deposit is required to hold/reserve a puppy. 606 Family Farm Co. accepts Venmo, and PayPal as payment options. The name of the puppy must be noted in your payment sent.

FINAL PAYMENT

Final payment is due at the time the puppy is picked up. If the puppy is being ground delivered or air delivered, payment will be required in full PRIOR to leaving.

REFUNDS OF DEPOSITS

Deposits made on existing litters of puppies are non-refundable. The deposit may be transferrable to another litter. 606 Family Farm Co. reserves the right to determine whether to transfer the deposit or not. If the decision is made to transfer the deposit, you will then have 1 year to use that deposit/credit. Following one year the deposit will no longer be applicable to any new purchases.

If you are making a deposit for a puppy from an upcoming/unborn litter, and the anticipated puppy becomes unavailable, we, 606 Family Farm Co. will refund your entire deposit or offer the option of replacing this puppy with another puppy from a current or future litter.
